

Dear Customer.

Florida Keys Aqueduct has reduced output from our Florida City plant, to relieve pressure on our system. We are asking for assistance from the public, in an effort to conserve water and rebuild our reserves.

FKAA is generating enough water to service our customers. However, we are limited in our ability to build our reserves; which have been depleted as a result of the leaks that occurred last week.

No conservation is too small. This includes less time running irrigation systems, faucets, showers, washing of boats, vehicles, etc. Any and all effort is greatly appreciated during this time, as we attempt to rebuild our water supply.

What has helped with some of the members I have spoken with is to look up 2019 numbers from Jan-March) and benchmark them to this year's Q1. From what I have heard thus far, many are up 15% to 30+% for the same quarter in 2019. Be sure to set realistic and appropriate expectations my esteemed members, it will provide better perspective and guidance as you move through 2023.




