## 50th ANNUAL MARATHON SEAFOOD FEST!!



It's March, which means the Original Marathon Seafood Festival is here! We hope to see you all at Marathon Community Park March 14th & 15th for our 50th (yes 50th) Original Marathon Seafood Festival. The Marathon Seafood Festival consists of over 13,000 festival guests, live entertainment and over 200 vendors, along with art booths, a boat show, kid's games and rides, and some new additions like a bloody-mary and on-the-rocks margarita bar, domestics and craft beers, and great entertainment like Amber Leigh (yes she is back), Island Vibe, The Marshall Morlock Band, and more!

The Marathon Seafood Festival brings in thousands of out-of-county guests each year to our Island having a \$6,500,000.00+ economic impact each year on our businesses and community. Regarding economic impact and working with our visitors, I am always so proud of the great job the staff in our Marathon Chamber & Visitor Center does; especially how well they work with visitors that stop into our visitors center, call, or email us asking for information about Marathon and the FL Keys. Most commonly we field questions on what to do, where to eat, stay, and play; so we may make their trip a memorable one.

- A Couple Visitor Center Fun Facts:
- Research shows that visitors who stop in the Marathon Visitor Center are likely to extend their stay by an average of three (3) days; this results in total additional visitor spending (includes accommodations) to the tune of \$4.5+ million per year.
- 7+% of our annual visitor center walk-ins arrive without reservations.
- Our customer service ratings are top notch!
- Our TripAdvisor rating is a perfect 5.0
- Our Google rating is 4.9/5.0

One of the Marathon Seafood Festival's goals is, other than putting heads-in-beds, is to enhance our visitors' experience and time here in the Islands of Marathon, and while we know the event attracts many to our islands, we want them to come back again. The seafood festival helps to do just that and we are proud of this two-fold effect our event has.

Your Marathon Seafood Festival also allows us and our event partner, the Organized Fishermen of Florida (Marathon Chapter), to give back to our great community. Between both our organizations over \$60,000.00 in event proceeds find their way back to local not-for-profits, scholarships for local students, and grants for chamber members (continuing education grants, etc.). We are equally proud of the "local benefits" our event provides, truly making the Marathon Seafood Festival a win-win for all.
